# Directions

From the Beach Line (SR 528): Take exit 49 and go north on Courtenay Pkwy (SR 3). Travel north on Courtenay for approximately 3 miles. Turn left on Porcher Road (look for the big St. Luke's sign on your left). Travel 0.3 miles and at the first stop sign, turn right on North Tropical Trail. St. Luke's is located on the left about 0.6 miles.

Sams House at Pine Island is located on N. Tropical Trail 1.1 miles past St. Luke's on the left.
